

Program description:

The Housing and Disability Advocacy Program (HDAP) provides assistance to individuals who are homeless or at risk of homelessness, are applying for a disability income benefit, and who meet certain other eligibility criteria.

Services include:

- Social work case management services that focus on securing stable housing; including assessment, care planning, in-person/phone contact
- Support and guidance from a special medical evaluation worker or veterans service specialist as the individual applies for disability income benefits
 - Other supportive services as identified and appropriate

To be eligible for services, an individual must meet the following criteria:

- Eligible for General Assistance or be a Military Veteran
- Applying for Social Security Disability or other disability income benefit
 - Homeless or at high risk of homelessness
 - Have the ability to live independently with supportive services
- Applicants are encouraged to participate in case management services
